

# ISFHWE Member Publication Promotion Project

ISFHWE members have the opportunity to display their publications at the **NGS National Conference** and **FGS National Conference** without buying an exhibit booth.

Here's how the project works:

- 📖 A donor may submit up to three (3) books for inclusion in the **ISFHWE Member Publication Project**. The contributor must be listed as an author, editor, or publisher of the book and be an active member of ISFHWE.
- 📖 Complete the submission form posted at ISFHWE.org, or in the File Cabinet of the ISFHWE Members-Only website at MyFamily.com. The completed form must be e-mailed to: ***ISFHWEBooks@isfhwe.org*** or mailed to the project coordinator to arrive at least three weeks before the relevant conference at the address shown on the form.
- 📖 One complimentary copy of each book to be included must be provided to ISFHWE for the conference. This copy will be displayed throughout the conference in the ISFHWE booth in the exhibit hall, allowing the attendees an opportunity to view the work of the member. At the conclusion of the conference it will be presented for donation to a genealogical repository in the area of the conference, thus contributing to ISFHWE's charitable mission. A bookplate will be placed in each book, including the ISFHWE name and logo and the donor's name.
- 📖 A catalog of the participating books will be published for distribution at the conference, and posted on the ISFHWE website where it will remain for at least one year. Please provide a TIF or JPG file of the book cover. The text description included on the form, the image of the book as submitted, and specific ordering instructions for all books will be included in the catalog.
- 📖 A fee equivalent to the selling price of the book must be paid (by check to ISFHWE or by using the PayPal button on the Project page) which will offset expenses incurred by ISFHWE for the project.

In addition, there will be a supply of copies of a catalog containing information about each book and cards with the ISFHWE website address. The catalogs will also be available for download on the ISFHWE public and members-only websites.

ISFHWE booth personnel will be encouraging passersby to take a copy of the catalog or the web address if they are interested in any of the books in order to place an order directly. No sales will be made from the ISFHWE booth nor by ISFHWE personnel.
